~	Look over the material on the website at destinybiblecollege.com
~	Decide how many students you would like to have. Suggested classroom size between 6 to 18 students or more
~	Decide on a beginning date to start the college
~	Begin to advertise the school at least two months before beginning and put together a contact list. Refer the prospective student to the website that will give basic information. Could also develop a handout, trifold, etc. for your specific school for purposes of advertising and information
~	Stay in contact with DR. Eddy Brown as you are formulating your school to determine cost and curriculum
~	To receive the first curriculum set and to be able to start the school you will need to pay a deposit of \$450.00 thirty days before the school starts. That monies will be in an escrow and will be applied to the beginning of the school.
	If for some reason you do not start a school, all escrow monies will be returned to you.
~	For every enrolled student we require a \$100.00 non-refundable enrollment fee one time only. This payment will go to missions. (This is why it is not refundable)
~	When the price of the curriculum is set for the school and the students, that amount will be paid monthly within the first two weeks of each trimester
~	Our suggested scheduling is to set up three courses to be done on one night with one extra night monthly for ministry school. In this manner, the student could receive an Associates in two years. Contact Dr. Brown for details regarding the Ministry School.

>	For the prospective teacher. Please note in the table of contents a detailed teaching guideline/lesson plan for each class.
>	Teachers are not required to have anything but a high school diploma to teach the undergraduate courses but it is a given that they need to have teaching skills, integrity and a proven Christian lifestyle.
<	For record keeping which is a must, sample grade sheets and other forms will be provided on request
>	For the teacher also, when the teacher reviews the materials one can see you cannot teach all the materials in the 45 minute session, therefore, the teacher will provide an overview and the students will do the rest by completing homework and taking tests
~	Every school will sign an agreement not to sell this material or start other schools without written permission from the home office
>	For foreign mission—If you need curriculum for your missionaries that is available and in most cases is free of charge.
